Transportation:

Applications for priority certificates for travel on the Marine Tiger and Marine Jumper were sent to Washington yesterday. As soon as we receive these priority certificates, we will submit them to the U.S. Lines. They must be accompanied by the enclosed application for passage, and by a check covering passage fare. Please fill out the enclosed form and return it to us immediately, along with your check.

The passage fare to Le Havre for men is \$250 round trip, \$127 one way. There are two possible fares for women, and, since we will not know which accommodations have been assigned until later, we are requesting women to make out checks for the higher amount of \$380 round trip, \$190 one way. The difference (\$23 one way) will be returned if lower price accommodations are assigned. All checks should be made payable to United States Lines.

We have applied for round-trip reservations, leaving N.Y. June 21 on the Marine Tiger, returning September 12 on the Marine Jumper, for the following people:

Passport applications:

Procedure for obtaining passports has at last been clarified in all its complexity. All people returning on the Marine Jumper, and all people with return passages by other means, should now apply for passports or permission to travel in Austria, as follows:

A. IF YOU HAVE NO PASSPORT, AND NEVER HAVE HAD ONE:

Go to the passport office nearest you (usually located in the Post Office Building). Take with you a friend who has known you for at least two years. Also take along a certified copy of your birth certificate (that is, a copy signed or stamped by the office issuing the birth certificate), and two photographs, 2 1/4 x 2 1/4". Fill out the official blank furnished by the clerk. Present the enclosed letter of identification to the clerk; this letter, except in cases noted below, will be sufficient for permission to travel in an occupied zone.

B. IF YOU HAVE A PASSPORT NOW NO LONGER VALID

Procedure same as above, except you do not need birth certificate and friend to identify you. Even if you have lost your old passport, statement that you had one will be sufficient.

C. IF YOU HAVE A VALID PASSPORT

If you will be in this country until after June 9, send your passport by registered mail to Mrs. Ruth C. Shipley, Chief, Passport Division, State Dept. Washington, D.C. Accompany the passport with the enclosed letter of identification and a request for a military permit to stay in Austria. Be sure to identify yourself in same manner as in letter of identification. If you are leaving the country before June 9, send the letter of identification and request for a military permit to Mrs. Shipley, asking that this be forwarded to that consulate of the country in which you will be where you may have it attached to your passport (Rome, Paris, etc.)

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE PROCEDURE, THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL PROCEDURE APPLIES:

1. Those returning on the Marine Jumper and leaving for Europe after June 9 on the Marine Tiger or otherwise, need only follow the above instructions where they apply.
2. Those planning to leave before June 9, will have to show some purpose other than the Salzburg Seminar to obtain a passport. They will also have to show that they have made arrangements for lodging, (see also C), and will have to have a certification of return passage, if they plan to return from Europe this summer.
3. Those not returning on the Marine Jumper, but leaving after June 9, should follow the above instructions in A, B, or C. They will, however, need some proof of a return passage, before they can apply for a passport (or else they must plan to stay in Europe after the summer). Members of the Seminar for whom we are engaging passage by air, and whose return reservations have as yet not been confirmed, will receive certificates of their return reservations as soon as we receive them. We will send them their letter of identification at that time.
